TSA/TA policy on seed exempts at ITF World Masters Tour Events

TSA and TA have reached an agreed position regarding the use of seed exempts at ITF World Masters Tour Events in Australia. The major change of note is that the TA/TSA National Selectors will no longer play a role in providing advice on seed exempts. It is the role of tournament committees to consider whether exceptional circumstances apply, with any seed exempts to be applied in line with the ITF World Masters Tour regulations.

The TSA/TA policy position is stated below:

TA/TSA recommend that seed exempts be only applied in exceptional circumstances at Australian ITF World Tennis Masters Tour events. Should an Australian ITF World Tennis Masters Tour tournament committee wish to apply seed exempts, these are to be applied in line with the current ITF World Tennis Masters Tour Regulations. The TA/TSA National Selectors will not play an active role in the seed exempt processes for these events.
